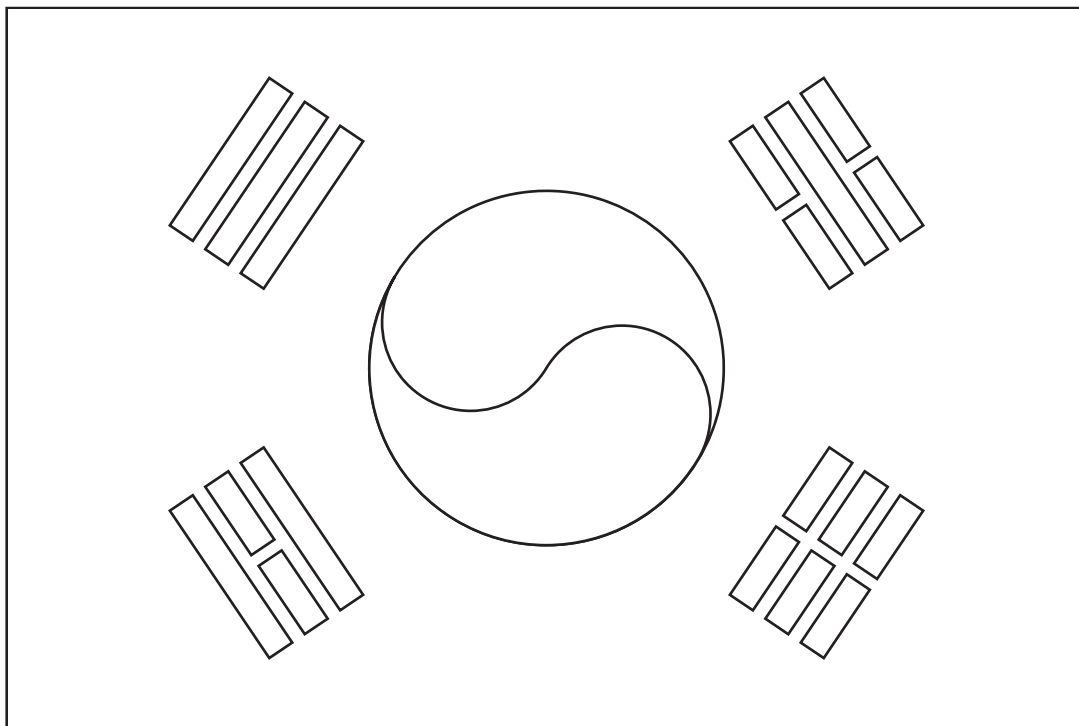
Let's make

The Korean flag (Taegeukgi) meanings

- The white background symbolizes purity and peacefulness.
- The four trigrams symbolize heaven, earth, water and fire.
- The Yin-yang in the middle symbolizes the harmony of the world.
- Therefore, 태극기 Taegeukgi represents the balance of the universe.
